## **FAQS**



### What are the details?

Beginning with the 2020-21 school year, children of Alumni receive 10% off tuition each year of enrollment. In addition, the new student admissions fee\* is waived completely (a value of \$200-1,400). It is the Alumni's responsibility at the time of application or enrollment to notify the Admissions Team that they qualify for the grant.

### Who is eligible to receive this grant?

The Alumni Tuition Grant is available to the children of PCA Alumni.

## Can I apply for financial aid in addition to the Alumni Tuition Grant?

Yes. If an applicant requires financial assistance beyond the 10% Alumni Grant, they will be encouraged to apply through FACTS, and financial aid will be determined based on level of need.

\*New Student Admission Fee: A one-time, non-refundable fee applies upon the acceptance of each new student. For the first student in each family, the fee is \$1,400; for each subsequent student from the same family, the fee is \$900 per student. The fee for new students entering Pre-Kindergarten is \$400, (if the new Pre-K student has a sibling at PCA, the fee is waived). This fee is waived for children of PCA graduates.
